ABOUT HEALTHY MOTHERS, HEALTHY BABIES

Our statewide programs focus on current maternal and child healthcare needs and include:

- 1. **providing services** to individual families and professionals,
- 2. **building coalitions** to improve the system of support for families, and
- 3. **advocating** for policy changes.

SERVICES

PERINATAL MENTAL HEALTH: HMHB leads statewide training and technical assistance efforts to improve the system of care for perinatal mental health. This includes hosting conferences and other training events, promoting best practice screening schedules, building peer support networks, promoting and supporting the PRISM telepsychiatry consultation service, and maintaining resource lists to help connect families with perinatal mood or anxiety disorders to support.

LIFTS: Linking Infants and Families To Supports (LIFTS) is an online resource directory with over 2,500 local resources and substance-limited events across Montana for families expecting or raising young children. LIFTS also offers a warmline for families to call into for help finding support, along with an annual magazine that shares stories, as told by Montana families, about "when help helps."

PURPLE Montana: HMHB coordinates this statewide program that educates about infant crying. Through this program, we help prevent abusive head trauma.

ESSENTIALS FOR BABY: In partnership with organizations across Montana, HMHB offers childcare items free of charge, which may include a crib and sleep sack along with educational materials about safe sleep; car seats and referrals to certified installers; or care items like diapers.

STORYTELLING: HMHB has developed a movement to give voice to the stories and experiences of parents and caregivers and connect them with one another through the Mother Love podcast, videos, LIFTS Magazine, and associated events.

COALITIONS

THE MONTANA EARLY CHILDHOOD COALITION: HMHB coordinates meetings and projects of local coalitions across the state to increase the impact of early childhood services and improve the health, safety, and well-being of Montana children and families.

PERINATAL MENTAL HEALTH COLLABORATIVE: Through this collaborative with other Montana entities, HMHB works to increase awareness of and services for pregnancy-related depression and other mood and anxiety disorders.

CHILDREN'S HEALTH DATA PARTNERSHIP PROJECT: HMHB has convened stakeholders to create a data dashboard with ten early childhood measures, which are used to track statistics and help direct public health efforts across Montana to improve the social determinants of children's health.

ADVOCACY

POLICY CHANGE AND ENGAGEMENT OPPORTUNITIES: HMHB participates in administrative and legislative policy change work and shares calls to action to improve maternal-child health outcomes with the HMHB partner network.
